A WORD ON WOUNDS

we all know that sometimes things do go wrong. And horses injuring themselves DOES happen! This blog is about cuts and fresh wound How you treat the wound in the first instance is paramount to a quick and good recovery. Too many times I hear of people putting on Lotagen, Yellow Lotion or very astringent medications on these fresh wounds only for them to ulcerate due to same. For a fresh wound, I wash the wound with saline water (you can make your own by

Despite our best efforts, filling a 25ml syringe with salt and tip this into 4 litres of warm water in a sprayer pack for ease of application) Then a mild cream can be applied. I currently use flamazine which is a human product though have heard of a terrific cream (and am waiting on my first order of it) that is apparently even better - called Equine Plus. Bandage is recommended as Wounds heal best in a regulated moist environment. though don't bandage too tight. It needs to be firm but don't go overboard For more on **Basic Wound** Management read here. It's well worth the time. It is
